# ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

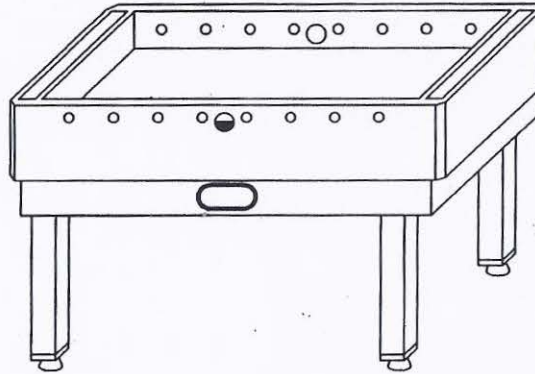
1. Place table with playing side down on flat surface.
2. Attach the legs using  $3/8"$  x  $1-3/8"$  bolts and  $3/8"$  flat washers through the side panels and the end panels.
3. Attach the leg levelers as down.
4. *CAREFULLY* Turn table to its upright position (two adults).



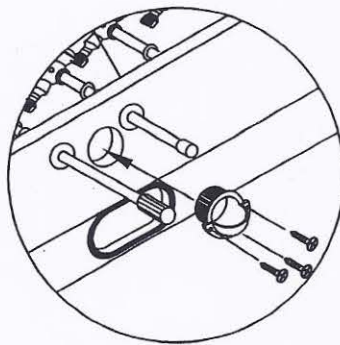

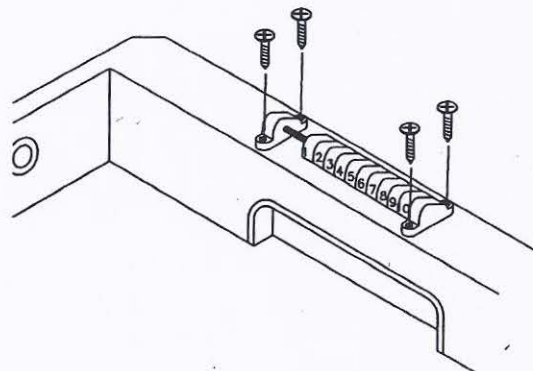
5. Place soccer table on top of assembled billiards table.



6. Attach the two black plastic ball entry cups to side panels of table with 5/8" round head phillips screws.



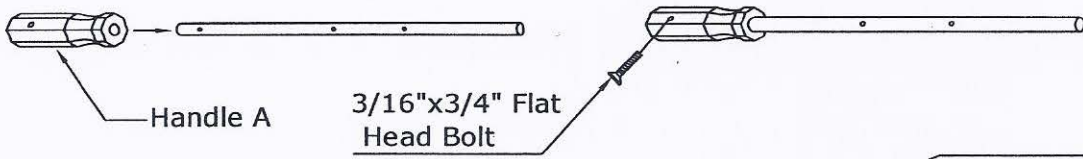
7. Attach the two sets of slide scorers and end brackets to the end of table with 5/8" round head phillips screws.



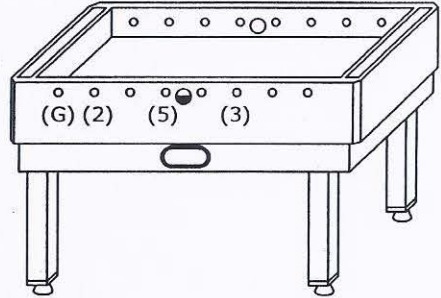
# ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

## 8. ROD ATTACHMENT

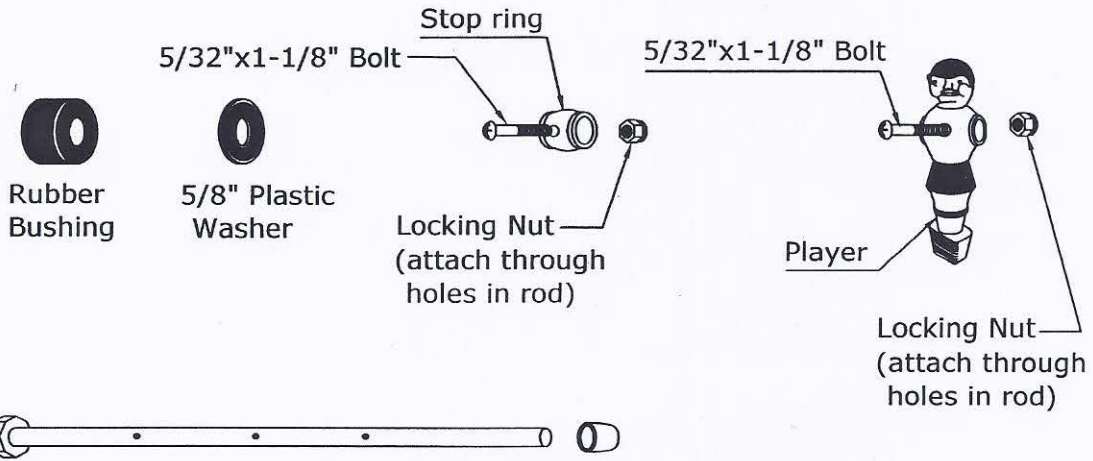
Push Wood handles onto rod ends that have a hole drilled 1/2" from the end and using 3/16"x3/4" Flat Head Bolt.



**IMPORTANT:** To prevent handles from coming off during play make sure handles are on as far as they can go, this can be done by holding the rod and tapping handle on floor. Spray rods with a glass cleaner to slide parts on easier.

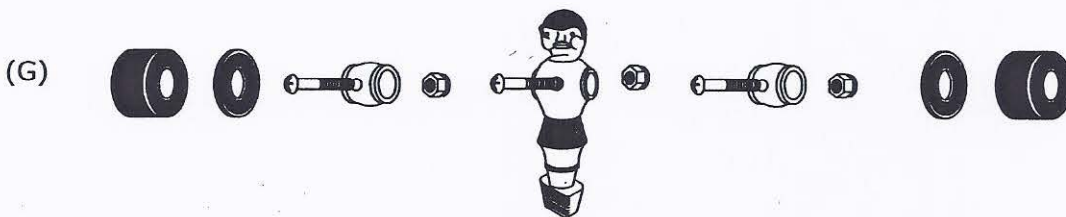


Use this diagram to identify rod order

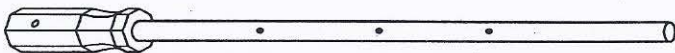


**NOTE:** Insert rod through one end panels hole only, slide on pieces and then insert through other end panel hole. Attach end caps to end of rod.

# ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

9. Once soccer top is firmly in place, slide the iron pins in both sides of table as shown below. These pins must be removed before changing tops again.
